- Improve the reliability and capability of existing resources
 - Address OPG and IESO concerns about dispatch volatility
 - Market efficiency improvements
 - Previous stakeholder engagement plan SE 9 on Dispatch Issues dealt with the operational side - we are now into the front end more complex changes.
- Ontario electricity infrastructure is going through perhaps the largest transition in it's history
 - Coal supply reduction and replacement
 - Gas fired facilities
 - Intermittent resources
 - Addition of distributed facilities and demand management

- Engage stakeholders one on one in June and July with respect to opportunities and concerns
- Publish a more detailed stakeholder plan in September based on input received
- Opportunity for consolidation of a number of initiatives;
 - Incorporation of single cycle gas
 - Enhanced inter-tie trading
 - Load following opportunities
