Subject: Our feedbacks on FPPG and DTWG meetings

FPPG Meeting :

Presentation on Floor Prices:

- Slide 5 Will be helpful to clarify this graph with typical example Nuc Gen # 1 dispatched, VG # 1 Dispatched, etc ... i.e., graphically represent the sequence of going off line and coming on .. Is it first one out, first one back, etc.?
- Re 2 questions in Slide 10 ... # 1 ... Thought there was a third price at which point the VG is proposed to be shut down. This will be a serious concern to us – especially during winter months. I thought at some point there was a discussion in DTWG – I think that the facilities will not be curtailed beyond a certain percentage ... such as 10% of name plate capacity or something similar. It is always harder and longer to come back on line – if the entire park is shut down. # 2 .. Prefer not to have a very firm time line .. at least initially. Will prefer review based on some basis that involves SE and the after a year or two into workable dispatch mode, every 6 months should be okay.
- Have a comment on Market Rule process .. please see below under DTWG response.

Publication:

- None. Acknowledge IESO hearing our feedback and making changes to Publication that is fair to all.

DTWG Meeting :

- This comment is generally about DTWG items. We are truly concerned about the tight timelines, especially in view of the fact that there are no clear time lines for OPA's process, without which all the co-operation and collective good work cannot be put to good use. Our impression on the Market Rule Changes was that there will be an opportunity for DTWG to review and comment in the draft rules before they are presented to the TP. I will endeavour to review some of my notes – may be able to be specific.
- Even though there are a number of generators that are familiar with the current Dispatch mechanism, hardware/software needs – there are still some that need to be educated as part of this process .. so anyone that is wanting to comment and give feed back to IESO and the TP during the Rule Change process, can do so. I will send a list of specific topics that need to be addressed in a future (not too distant) DTWG meeting - by Monday / Tuesday next week.
- I think, ideally - we should get an indication of Market Manual process for the next DTWG meeting this month.
- The comment that we heard from IESO ... “Review .. review some more and as much as necessary and then agree” seems to be fading away.
