**Re: Application by the Independent Electricity System Operator for the  
Licence Renewal - EI-2003-0088**

The Independent Electricity System Operators (the "IESO") is currently licensed by the Ontario Energy Board ("the Board") under Licence EI-2003-0088. The Licence is due to expire on July 30, 2008. Accordingly, the IESO hereby applies under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (the "Act") for a renewal of its current licence required under sub-sections 57(g) and (h) of the Act to direct the operation of transmissions systems in Ontario and operate the market established by the Market Rules.

**A. The Applicant**

The IESO was established on April, 1999, and has been continued as a corporation without share capital pursuant to Part II and section 4 of the *Electricity Act, 1998*. The objects of the IESO are set out in section 5 of the *Electricity Act, 1998* and, include,

"s. 5(1)(b) to enter into agreements with transmitters giving the IESO authority to direct the operations of their transmission systems;

(c) to direct the operation and maintain the reliability of the IESO-controlled grid to promote the purposes of [the Electricity Act];

(g) to operate the IESO-administered markets to promote the purposes of [the Electricity Act].

Under section 32(1) of the *Electricity Act, 1998*, the IESO may make rules governing the IESO-controlled grid and establishing and governing markets related to electricity and ancillary services.

Each year under section 19 of the *Electricity Act, 1998*, the Board must approve the IESO's proposed expenditure and revenue requirements for the year and the fees the IESO proposes to charge.

#### **B. The Application**

The IESO is applying for a renewal of its current Licence EI-2003-0088 under section 60 of the Act to exercise the powers and perform the duties of the IESO under the *Electricity Act, 1998*. The IESO requests that the Board re-issue it a five (5) year Licence in the form attached as Appendix "A" to take effect on July 31, 2008. The IESO has proposed some minor modifications to the provisions in its current Licence as set out in Appendix "A" to this letter for the Board's consideration.

Under the *Electricity Restructuring Act, 2004*, the Market Surveillance Panel was transferred to the Ontario Energy Board from the IESO effective January 1, 2005. The Panel was continued as a panel of the Board pursuant to subsection 4.3.1(1) of the Act. Accordingly, the provisions in sections 16 and 17 in the current Licence are no longer applicable to the IESO. These licence conditions were put in by a Ministerial Directive issued to the Board on March 24, 1999 (OIC No. 600/99). It is the IESO's understanding that a Ministerial Directive is required for the proposed changes to those provisions in the licence that were put in by a directive and that no directive has been issued to the Board to date to amend those provisions.

#### **C. Information about Each Key Individual at the IESO**

Information about each officer and director of the IESO is set out in Appendices "B" and "C" to this application.

#### **D. Procedural Matters**

The number of parties potentially affected by this application is large, including all market participants authorized under the IESO's Market Rules, all transmitters, distributors, retailers, wholesalers and generators in Ontario, as well as any parties in other jurisdictions. To effect individual service of this application on each such person would be very expensive. The IESO

therefore proposes that notice of this application be given by the following means:

- (i) posting this letter application, including Appendices "A", "B", and "C" on the IESO's website at the "IESO News and Notices" and "Regulatory Affairs" pages;
- (ii) distributing by electronic mail to all market participants and interested parties who are registered to receive IESO news and other communiqués that the letter of application has been posted.
